

2025 - 26 Grain Policies

Hours of Operation

Rembrandt Location - 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m., Monday – Friday

Harvest Hours - 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m., Monday – Friday - Weekends as needed

Grain Disposition

- Producers must advise intentions for each load of grain
- Grain disposition must be established within 30 days, or it will be priced at the close of the market on day 30
- Inform scale house at the time of delivery if the grain ticket is to be split and how

Corn

- Moisture Base: 15% on all delivered bushels
- Moisture averaged up to 10 days after delivery; tickets are averaged in order of receipt
- Drying and Handling Shrink: 1.5% per point removed from wet corn
- Moisture Discount: \$0.05 per point removed applied to all wet bushels
- Drying charges subject to market conditions

Quality Standards

- Maximum Foreign Material (F.M.): 3%
- Maximum Damage: 3%
- Minimum Test Weight: 54 lbs
- Discounts apply for grain not meeting quality standards – contact your representative for the discount schedule
- Rembrandt reserves the right to reject any corn not meeting standards or found with objectionable foreign odor (COFO) or toxins (Aflatoxin, Vomitoxin, T2, Fumonisin)

Grain Check Processing

- Grain tickets applied in order received
- All payments handled via ACH - Processed next business day if settled after noon
